## **Statement of Environmental Policy - Refinery Auckland Pipeline**

The 170-kilometre pipeline is a key asset for the refinery and New Zealand and is the major source of transport fuels for greater Auckland and Auckland International Airport. The single 10-inch wide pipe (250mm) carries diesel, petrol and jet fuel in controlled batches under farmland, towns and part of the Manukau Harbour to the Wiri Terminal in South Auckland.

It is the policy of the Company to conduct its business and the operation of the RAP in a manner that is compatible with the balanced environmental and economic needs of the communities in which it operates and interfaces with.

The Company is committed to continuous efforts to improve environmental performance throughout its operations.

Accordingly, this statement summarises that our policy is to:

- comply with all applicable environmental laws and regulations and develop and apply responsible standards where laws and regulations do not exist;
- encourage concern and respect for the environment, emphasise every employee's responsibility in environmental performance and ensure appropriate operating practices and training;
- work with government and industry groups to foster timely development of effective environmental laws and regulations based on sound science and considering risks, costs and benefits and effects on energy and product supply;
- manage our business and the operation of the RAP with the goal of preventing incidents and of controlling emissions and wastes to below harmful levels; design, operate and maintain facilities to this end;
- respond quickly and effectively to incidents resulting from operations, cooperating with industry organisations and authorised government agencies;
- conduct and support research to improve understanding of the impact of our business and the operation of the RAP on the environment, to improve methods of environmental protection, and to enhance its capability to make operations and products compatible with the environment;
- communicate with the public on environmental matters and share our experience with others to facilitate improvements in industry performance;
- Undertake appropriate reviews and evaluations of the RAP and related operations to measure progress and to ensure compliance with this policy.
